

# Fall 2008 Art Student Exhibit Call for Entries

Waubonsee Community College Art Department announces a call for entries for the Fall 2008 Student Art Exhibit. The exhibit will be held November 10<sup>th</sup> – December 9th, 2008 in the Arrowhead Room, Dickson Center, Sugar Grove campus. The installation date is November 7th and the take down date is December 10th.

Each class is invited to enter **ONE (1)** artwork from the **current semester** into the exhibit. Instructors have the choice to nominate a piece themselves, or have the class vote on which piece to nominate. **Instructors must email, or deliver the student entry form to the Art Coordinator's office (VON 239) no later than November 4th, 2008.** Students must fully complete the forms then have the instructor sign and turn them in. Selected artwork must be properly prepared and framed for installation under the supervision of the instructor. Instructors are expected to help students prepare their artwork to be gallery ready. **All artwork must be delivered ready to display/hang by November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2008** in Von 200. Accepted artwork can be removed from the Arrowhead Room at the end of the exhibition 11:00a.m. on December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2008. All remaining work will be returned to Von Ohlen 200. *Pieces on paper/2-D must be matted and framed with a wire securely attached to the back. Paintings stretched on canvas need only to be wired in the back. 3-dimensional pieces need to be placed on the counter between both sinks in Von Ohlen 200 and be ready to be handled and transported. (Wrapped etc...)*

- **No late entries will be accepted.**
- **The instructor must send in all entry forms. (Email or drop off)**
- **We reserve the right to exclude ill-prepared artwork.**

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

**Entry Forms:** MAKE COPIES – Instructors must deliver or email **fully completed** entry form to the Art Coordinator. A copy of the **fully completed** entry form must accompany all artwork. Please secure a copy of the entry form on the back of the 2D work, or bottom of the 3-D work. ***\* Students must declare a value for the artwork whether or not it is for sale, or it will not be accepted.***

**Entry Drop-off Location:** Von Ohlen 200, 2D pieces in racks, 3D pieces on counter between sinks.

**Exhibition Location:** Arrowhead Room, Dickson Center, Sugar Grove campus.

**Restrictions:** Only 1 artwork nominated per class, all work must be under 60lbs and fit through the doors of the college. No late entries will be accepted. All paper/2-D artwork must be matted and framed with a wire attached to the back about 1/3 down from the top. No saw-tooth hangers, or bendable poster frames will be accepted. Paintings stretched on canvas need only to be wired in the back. 3-D pieces need to be placed on counter between both sinks and be ready to be handled and transported. A copy of the completed entry form signed by the student and the instructor must accompany all artworks.

**Artwork that does not meet **all** of the restrictions, requirements, and due dates will not be part of the exhibit.**
